3. ***All accepted poster, podiums, knowledge market & research proposal presenters must register for the conference and are responsible for their registration fee, travel, and all expenses related to the conference.***

Poster & Podium Abstract Submission Format

Poster Presentations will be during the 1 hour poster display time. Upon acceptance more details will be provided.

Podium presentations will be 30 minutes to include question and answer time.

5. Identify which learning outcome your abstract addresses, can be more than one
6. Identify if you are submitting for Podium, Poster, Knowledge Market and/or Research Proposal Workshop
7. Abstract content- must include:
 - a. Problem/Purpose relevant to conference theme/learning outcomes
 - b. Background
 - c. Discussion of issue or concepts/variables of interest
 - d. Population, sample, setting if research & description of community resource

- e. Methods (research) or interventions (practice/teaching)
- f. Findings, conclusions & implications
- g. References (required)

Knowledge Market Submission Format

Knowledge Market brings together community organizations, patients and healthcare professionals to increase collaboration, accelerate dissemination of research, connect patients/community partners and healthcare providers, stimulate knowledge sharing, find solutions to healthcare challenges.

Each Knowledge Market will be provided a table and a poster board (to display a research poster or any other information). The healthcare provider and the community partner will sit at the table, attendees will come by with a "passport", talk with the market and exchange knowledge. The market will stamp the passport and the attendee will either sign in at the market table or give a business card.

Research Proposal Workshop Submission format

The workshop is designed to facilitate the generation of research, DNP, or Quality Improvement project proposals consistent with strategies for improving or building community-directed healthcare along the lifecourse model. The workshop will guide participants in developing a plan for identifying and engaging community partners to co-produce research or DNP project questions that will address outcomes which are important to the populations that suffer from health disparities.
